<u>Modals</u>

- 1) <u>Can</u> = יכול
- Present: "I can do that" (subject+can+V1) "I can't do that" (subject+can't+V1) "Can you do that?" (can+subject+V1)
- Past: "I could do that" (subject+could+V1) "I couldn't do that" (subject+couldn't+V1) "Could you do that?" (subject+could+V1)

* We can use the word "could" also in the Present, when it's a polite request.

Future: "I will be able to do that" (subject + will be able to+V1)
 "I won't be able to do that" (subject+won't be able to+V1)
 "Will you be able to do that?" (will+subject+be able to+V1)

2) <u>Must</u> = חייב

- Present: "I must go" (subject+must+V1) "I don't have to go" (subject+don't/doesn't have to+V1) "Must you go?" (must+subject+V1)
- Past: "I had to go" (subject+had to+V1) "I didn't have to go" (subject+didn't have to+V1) "Did you have to go?" (did+subject+have to+V1)
- Future: "I will have to go" (subject+will have to+V1)
 "I won't have to go" (subject+won't have to+V1)
 "Will you have to go?" (will+subject+have to+V1)

3) <u>Should (ought to)</u> = צריך, כדאי

Present, Past, Future: "I should go" (subject+should+V1) "I shouldn't go" (subject+shouldn't+V1) "Should you go?" (should+subject+V1)

4) <u>Mustn't</u> = אסור

Present, Past, Future: "I mustn't smoke here" (subject+mustn't+V1)

5) <u>May (might)</u> = (עשוי, עלול) אולי (עשוי, עלול)

- Present, Future: "I may go home" (subject+may/might+V1) "I may not go home" (subject+may not+V1) "May I go home?" (may/might+subject+V1)
- Past:"I might go home" (subject+might+V1)"I might not go home" (subject+might not+V1)"Might he go home?" (might+subject+V1)
